ITx 2016: What's new?

This year ITx 2016 brings together 12 successful tech conferences from itSMFnz, IITP, CITRENZ, PMINZ, TUANZ, Testing Professionals Network, Health Informatics NZ, InternetNZ, NZRise, NZTech, Agile Day, and the NZ Open Source Society, creating the broadest and largest independent IT conference in New Zealand. The New Zealand Excellence in IT Awards are a sector-wide awards programme focusing on recognising those individuals and teams that have truly excelled in our industry. Winners will be announced at the Excellence in IT Awards Gala Dinner as part of ITx, on the evening of Tuesday 12 July 2016.

What makes the Excellence in IT Awards different is that they recognise the real people behind software and information technology – the people that make IT work.

While other awards programmes do an excellent job of recognising the companies and vendors who do great work, the Excellence Awards are focused squarely at the unsung heroes of our sector: our people.

Excellence in IT Awards Partnership

Awards Partners are the top-level partners for the Excellence in IT Awards. Partners will receive "In association with" recognition through most of the Awards marketing material and regularly on the night. To ensure the integrity of the awards there will be a minimum of two and a maximum of three Awards Partners.

TRADE EXHIBITION

A trade exhibition will be held at the conference. In order to provide you with the optimum exposure to delegates the exhibition will be located in a dedicated exhibition area, as well the foyer and common areas of the venue.

Stands include side and back partitioned walls. Tabletop stands include a table, pull-up sign and power but no partition walls. Tabletop stands will be moved during the Awards dinner.

Each stand will include the following:

- 2 x 100 watt spot lights (stands only)
- · A trestle table, table cloth and a chair
- Installation and removal of basic set up

Any additional requirements will be the responsibility of exhibitors and at their own cost.

Site

The trade exhibition area floor plan (available soon) will show the sites of trades exhibition stands. Sponsors will have first option for positions, followed by those exhibiting without sponsorship on a first-in, first-served basis.

Exhibitor Benefits

Each exhibiting company will receive the following benefits:
